PCDE can look back on another successful year where PCDE officially welcomed two new members, Dr. Ana Cebrián from Spain, responsible for website and social media and Dr. Philippe-Richard Domeyer who joined the board as treasurer. The board members contributed and participated in many meetings in 2019; they organised a diabetes track at WONCA Bratislava, Dr. Xavier Cos gave a lecture at EASD Barcelona, and Dr. Sam Seidu organised a EASD-PCDE Study Group symposium at EASD. We participated in many meetings such as the EFPIA meetings, gave lectures at the FEND and ESWI flu meetings. The EASD-PCDE Study Group published a Position statement and is now working on a second one. In 2019 PCDE issued for the second year a research grant of €35000 for research studies in primary care. Four projects have been selected and in progress. Papers will be published in PCD journal. For 2020 PCDE is organising a multidisciplinary Summit to improve primary care management of Diabetes in Northern Europe and of course the 16th International PCDE conference in Barcelona. Title: Positioning GLP1-RA agonist in the management of people with type 2 diabetes.

Content:

- Understand and describe the key aspects of the ADA/EASD Consensus report for management of T2DM, regarding the importance of patient centred care and the decision cycle underpinning assessment, shared decision making and on-going management and support.
